Emilio “Millo” José López Flores

Emilio “Millo” José López Flores passed away the morning of March 2, 2023, surrounded by his family at the age of 84.

Millo was born May 12, 1938, to Rafael López Ramirez and Sabita Flores Quintero in Canóvanas, Puerto Rico. A hard-worker from a young age, Millo began working at his family-owned farm. He studied Business Administration and, in 1961, enlisted in the Army and was deployed to Germany. He married the love of his life, Gloria Casalduc, on May 20, 1962. With his wife, he raised three children, in San Juan, Puerto Rico and looked after his brothers after the untimely death of his parents.

A leader and extremely intelligent man, Millo quickly moved up the corporate ladder after 3 years in the Army. Millo proudly started working with IBM in 1965. He received the Felix Ochoteco Award from the Phi Eta Mu Fraternity in 1976 and became president of Phi Eta Mu Supreme Counsel in 1978. His job moved him to Atlanta in 1984 with his family where he spent 15 years. After retiring from IBM, he moved with his wife to Leesburg, FL where he lived the rest of his days.

Emilio was Millo, Papi, Dad, Abuelo or Yeyo to his loved ones. He was a

strong, independent, and charismatic man. Millo enjoyed the simple things in life, like an ice-cold Yeungling, watching the Atlanta Braves, and spending time with his dog Mitzy. He loved to share stories about his early life, professional life, and the daily happenings. He never failed to make people smile and often enjoyed cracking jokes. Millo was the life of the party and always wanted to make people dance and sing.

Millo was a very loving man, he loved his wife and family deeply, and was extremely proud of them. He never let anyone take advantage of him and taught his family to do the same. He exemplified what it meant to be a selfless leader in all aspects of life. He was a true fighter until the very end.

Millo was preceded in death by his parents, Rafael & Sabita, and his brothers, Rafael & Agustin.

Millo is survived by his wife, Gloria, his children, Alfredo, Carmen & Juan Carlos, and his grandchildren, Natalia, Anna, Alfred & Nash.

A Celebration of Life for Millo will take place on Tuesday, March 14th, 2023 at 10:30 am at Florida National Cemetery of Bushnell, FL. Emilio "Millo" José López Flores falleció la mañana del 2 de marzo de 2023 rodeado de su familia a la edad de 84 años.

Millo nació el 12 de mayo de 1938 de Rafael López Ramírez y Sabita Flores Quintero en Canóvanas, Puerto Rico. Trabajador incansable desde muy

joven, Millo comenzó a trabajar en la granja de su familia. Estudió administración de Empresas; y en 1961, se alistó en el Ejército y fue destinado a Alemania. Se casó con el amor de su vida, Gloria Casalduc, el 20 de mayo de 1962. Con su esposa, crió a tres hijos en San Juan, Puerto Rico y cuidó a sus hermanos después de la prematura muerte de sus padres.

Un líder y un hombre extremadamente inteligente, Millo ascendió rápidamente en la escala corporativa después de 3 años en el ejército. Millo comenzó a trabajar con orgullo en IBM en 1965. Recibió el Premio Félix Ochoteco de la Fraternidad Phi Eta Mu en 1976 y se convirtió en presidente del Consejo Supremo de Phi Eta Mu en 1978. Su trabajo lo trasladó a Atlanta en 1984 con su familia, donde pasó 15 años. Después de retirarse de IBM, se mudó con su esposa a Leesburg, FL, donde vivió el resto de sus días.

Emilio era Millo, Papi, Papá, Abuelo o Yeyo para sus seres queridos. Era un hombre fuerte, independiente y carismático. Millo disfrutó de las cosas simples de la vida, como un Yeungling helado, ver jugar a los Bravos de Atlanta y pasar tiempo con su perro Mitzy. Le encantaba compartir historias sobre sus primeros años de vida, su vida profesional y los acontecimientos diarios. Nunca dejaba de hacer sonreír a la gente y, a menudo, disfrutaba contando chistes. Millo era el alma de la fiesta y siempre quiso hacer bailar y cantar a la gente.

Millo era un hombre muy cariñoso, amaba profundamente a su esposa y a su familia y estaba extremadamente orgulloso de ellos. Nunca dejó que nadie se aprovechara de él y le enseñó a su familia a hacer lo mismo. Ejemplificó lo que significaba ser un líder desinteresado en todos los aspectos de la vida. Fue un verdadero luchador hasta el final.

A Millo le precedieron en la muerte sus padres, Rafael y Sabita; y sus

hermanos, Rafael y Agustín.

Millo deja su esposa, Gloria; sus hijos, Alfredo, Carmen y Juan Carlos; y sus nietos, Natalia, Anna, Alfred y Nash.

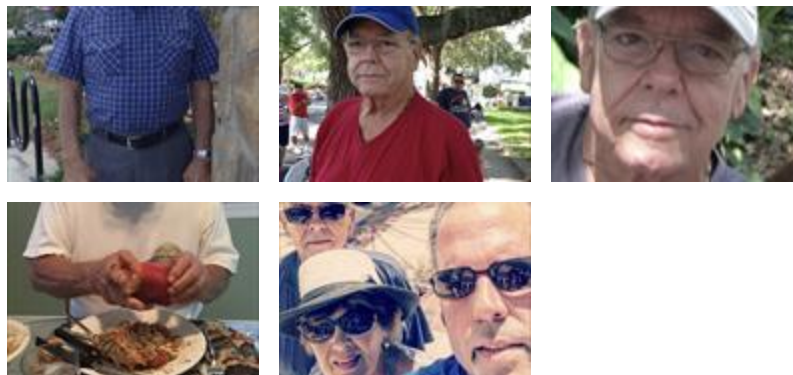
