Obituary of Erlaine Hester

Erlaine Hester, 85, a resident at Lakeview Retirement Community in Altoona, FL, died Tuesday, September 2, 2014. Erlaine was born on July 21, 1929 in Whitney, Florida to Earle and Katherine Ross Hester. She was a fifth generation Floridian, descending from Thomas Robertson who homesteaded in the Leesburg area in 1842. After graduating from Leesburg High School in 1947, Erlaine worked for six years at the family business, Hester & Stinson Lumber Company. In 1953, Erlaine set off to acquire a higher education earning a BA degree from Howard College (Samford Center) in Birmingham, AL in 1957, a MA degree in 1958, and guidance counselor requirements in 1959, from George Peabody College (now Vanderbilt University) in Nashville, TN.

Erlaine worked as a faculty member at Florida State University in Tallahassee as a resident counselor for freshman women for five years. In 1964, Erlaine accepted a position as a guidance counselor at Ft. Lauderdale High School, where she worked for the next 25 years. After retiring in 1989, Erlaine moved back to her hometown of Leesburg where she lived until moving to Altoona in 2010.

Erlaine enjoyed travel, family get-togethers and sports! Anyone who knew her realized she was an avid Seminole fan!!

Erlaine was predeceased by her parents; sister, Jacquelyn; brother, Earle Jr and sister-in-law, Mary Julia. She is survived by her nephew, Jeff (Doris) of East Lake Weir; great nephew, Jarrod (Kimberly); great-great niece, Julia of Micanopy; great niece, Lindsay Nunez(Adam); great-great nephews, Connor and Wade of Gainesville; nephew, Judson (Mary Louise) of Tallahassee and great nephews, Paul of Miami and Pierce of Tallahassee.
