Ernest Oberlin Corneliussen, 95, Lady Lake, FL passed away on Saturday, January 27, 2018. He was born in Minnesota. He was a WWII Army veteran, married Betty in 1945. They owned and operated the Charloe store in Charloe, Ohio for 15 years. In 1962 they moved to Lady Lake, FL where they owned and operated Ernie's Chevron Service Station in Lady Lake. He continued to work through his 80's, never really retiring. Ernie was known as a "Jack of all trades".
