Everett "Stewart" Swain (95) of Leesburg, FL passed away suddenly at the UFHealth Leesburg Hospital in Leesburg, FL January 13, 2021. He was born August 2, 1925 in Niagara Falls, Ontario, Canada.

Stewart is survived by his beloved wife of 62 years, Margot A. Friz Swain; his brother Henry A.
