Obituary of Floyd Miller

Floyd Joseph Miller, Jr., 58, was born June 4th, 1955 in Philadelphia, Pennsylvania and went home to the Lord on December 7, 2013 (Leesburg, FL). Having grown up around Pennsylvania (as well as Virginia and New Jersey), Floyd was lovingly called "Butchie" by his parents, family, and friends; excelling in academics. Floyd attended college at Wilkes University, earning a double major Bachelors in Political Science & English. Thereafter, he attended Rensselaer Polytechnic Institute for his Masters in Technical Writing, which would be the platform for his careers. Floyd's first career was at Prudential as a technical writer for 16 years. During his time of employment, he met his ex-wife, Dawn Gregory and was married December 11th, 1982, which yielded his only son & offspring, Matthew Gregory Miller on December 9th, 1987. In 1994, the family re-located to Tampa, Florida after being let go from Prudential, which Floyd has considered home ever since. In 1997, Floyd began his career at Geac Public Safety as a technical writer for the years until his first hospitalization. It was 2002 that Floyd first became fatally ill due to a spider bite and after 2 years was healed. However, it was not an easy life after that as there were several illnesses that came as a result. In 2011 began Floyd's in and out lifestyle of the hospital, this past year being the worst. It is with such peacefulness that his family knows that he is no longer suffering. Floyd is preceded in death by his father, Floyd J. Miller, Sr. and is survived by his

mother, Esther Miller; his wonderful son, Matthew G. Miller; his beautiful daughter-in-law, Chelcie Miller; his ex-wife, Dawn Provoyeur, and his faithful dog, Bear. Floyd is being cremated and will be buried with his parents. Memorial service will be December 15th, 2013 at Lake Square Presbyterian Church, 2pm.
