



## Fr. Loring W. Chadwick

September 22, 1932 - April 26, 2019

Fr. Loring W. Chadwick, 86, a resident of Lake Port Square in Leesburg, Florida, passed away peacefully on April 26, 2019. Loring was born in Rhode Island where he spent most of his life, until moving to Ocala, FL in 1994 and then Leesburg, FL in 2016. Loring received a B.A in Philosophy from Brown University in 1954, Master of Divinity from the Episcopal Divinity School, Cambridge MA in 1957, and a Master of Education from Rhode Island College in 1967.

Loring was a music teacher for 28 years in the Cumberland, RI public school system. He co-founded the Cumberland-Lincoln Community Chorus and served as co-director for 12 years.

Fr. Chadwick was ordained to the Priesthood in 1958 and served in many capacities at various locations throughout the Rhode Island diocese: Church of the Holy Spirit in Charlestown, All Saints Memorial in Providence, Trinity Church in Newport, Cathedral of St. John in Providence, Christ Church in Lincoln, Emmanuel Church in Cumberland, and Grace Memorial in East Providence. After moving to Ocala, he joined the Church of the Advent in Dunnellon assisting as the Director of Music.

A funeral service will be held at 11:00 am on Saturday, 18 May, at St. James Episcopal Church in Leesburg, Florida, followed by a remembrance at Lake Port Square.
