Obituary of Frances Stegall

Frances Rivers Stegall, 63, of Longwood, Florida, died Tuesday, September 27, 2011 at Hospice of the Comforter in Altamonte Springs, FL. She was born in Eustis, FL and was a lifelong resident of Leesburg, FL until she moved to Longwood, FL in 1978. She was a member of the Wekiva Presbyterian Church in Longwood, FL. She was a graduate of Leesburg High School and Florida State University where she was a member of Kappa Kappa Gamma Sorority. She was a fifth grade teacher at Spring Lake Elementary School at Ocoee, FL since 1988. In 2009 she was awarded Reading Teacher of The Year and in 2010 she was awarded Teacher of The Year at Spring Lake Elementary School. She was active in youth and varsity sports and enjoyed her students and family. The New Spring Lake Elementary School is now under construction and the Media Center will be named "The Frances Stegall Media Center" in honor of her 23 years of dedication and media service with her students and associates.

She is survived by her husband of 39 years, Barry Stegall of Longwood, FL; two sons, Randy (Laura)Stegall of DeLand, FL and Chuck(Melanie)Stegall of Port Orange, FL; daughter, Julie Anne(Blake)Collier of Apopka, FL; brother, Chuck(Patty)Rivers of Longwood, FL; three grandchildren, Zach Collier, Alex Collier and Sarah Anne Stegall.
