Obituary of Frank Aversa

Frank Aversa, a resident of Leesburg, Florida, passed away of lung cancer on November 10, 2014 surrounded by his loving family and friends. He was 73 years old.

Frank Aversa was born October 25, 1941, in Baltimore, Maryland, the son of the late Joseph and Eva (Perry) Aversa. He spent much of his childhood and a good portion of his young career working and raising a family in Baltimore. In 1983, he and wife, Joanna, moved to Richmond, Virginia to continue their careers.
