Obituary of Frank Domanick

Frank Domanick, 91, died Tuesday, December 29, 2015, to be united with Ruth, his beloved wife of 54 years. Mr. Domanick was born June 10, 1924 in Whitestone Queens, NY. He proudly served his country while a SGT in the 517th artillery battalion of the US Army, seeing combat in the Pacific theater, notably, the Solomons and the Philippines. He returned to NY City where he married and raised his family and forged a career as a Track and Third Rail Foreman in the NY City Metropolitan Transit Authority until his retirement in 1977. Mr. Domanick retired to Sarasota, FL and over time moved to enjoy Naples, The Villages and Leesburg. He is predeceased by his wife, Ruth, and is survived by his sister, Dorothy Kehoe; his children, Robert (Dale), Thomas (Stephanie), and daughter Suzanne Vitkus (James); 10 grandchildren; and 2 great grandchildren. Memorial services for Mr. Domanick will be held at 10 AM, on Friday, January 8, at Beyers Funeral Home Chapel, Leesburg, with Pastor Marc Spaeth officiating.
