Obituary of Frank Mezzatesta

Frank Paul Mezzatesta, 88, The Villages, FL died Friday, October 5, 2012. Frank was born in New York City, NY and moved to The Villages in 1986 from Lehigh Acres, FL. He was a retired real estate broker in New York and Connecticut and worked for Barden Corporation for 21 years. He was Catholic by faith and attended St. Timothy's Catholic Church in Lady Lake. He was a US Army veteran of WWII during which time he was a prisoner of war. Frank was Post Commander of the Lehigh Acres Chapter POW; member of the Ex-prisoners of War, Lake Monroe Chapter, Leesburg; D.A.V. 150, The Villages; American Legion Post #347, Lady Lake, FL; the Hangers Fliers, The Villages; VFW 10126, The Villages. Frank was the founder and chairman of The Villages Veteran's Memorial Park.
