Obituary of Franklin Bordenkircher

Franklin Eugene "Gene" Bordenkircher, age 83, was born in Quincy, IL on August 10, 1931, the son of Emmett and Wilma (Illman) Bordenkircher and passed away at 6:25 a.m. on Friday, April 24, 2015 at Leesburg Regional Medical Center, Leesburg, FL. He attended rural Quinlan and Hersman grade schools and graduated from St. Mary's Academy in Mt, Sterling, IL with the class of '49. Following high school he served in the U.S. Navy during the Korean conflict. He then attended and graduated from Clemson College (now Clemson University). He then began a career with the Department of Defense as an architect working for the Air Force, Navy, and Marine Corps in Cuba, Okinawa, Bermuda, and The White House during JFK's Presidency, and Quantico, VA. Upon his retirement he moved to Lady Lake (The Villages) FL where he spent the rest of his lifetime

He is survived by brothers and sisters Richard (Carol) Bordenkircher of Rolling Meadows, IL; Don Bordenkircher of Houston, TX; Charlotte (Gary) McPeck and Marcia (Pat) Cummings of Springfield, IL; special friend Mavis from the UK; and several nieces and nephews.
