



## Franklin Bruce Cole Jr.

Franklin Bruce Cole, Jr, 66, of The Villages, Florida, passed away on November 7, 2025. 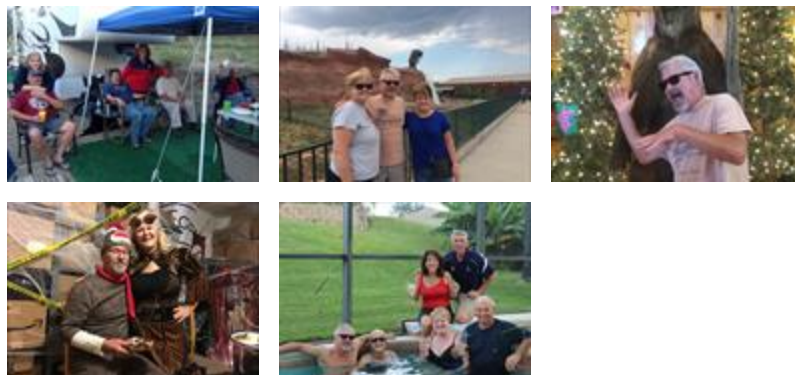
