Gary has traveled all over the world for his work as a Superintendent Electrician. During his time in Africa he did multiple selfless acts of kindness. He made sure the people around him were fed. If they weren't he would take some food from the buffet his work had every night, and would give it to them. He would always buy lots of peanuts and candies from little girls. He even helped a man give wood to his settlement, so that they could make beds. He did everything in his power so that these people wouldn't just have to just sleep on wooden frames. He sent a woman into town to buy cloth and other materials so that these people would have some kind of mattress. He saved animals that came into the construction site that got stuck in machinery. Throughout his life he has helped people and gave back to the community. He was one of few to volunteer during the draft for the war in Vietnam. He worked all of his life to provide for his children and family. He was a wonderful husband, father, grandfather, brother, and friend. He was truly a kind hearted man and thought of others before himself.

Gary E. Harvey is survived by his wife Michelle Harvey, and his seven daughters.
