Obituary of Gary Jones

Gary Wayne Jones of Summerfield, FL, passed away on February 22, 2010. He was born in Gainesville, TX on February 7, 1942 to Elbert and Reva Jones. Gary graduated from Gainesville High School in 1960 and joined the United States Air Force the same year. After his tour in the Air Force, Gary joined the Federal Bureau of Investigation. He was a Supervisory Fingerprint Specialist in the Latent Fingerprint Section as well as a Team Leader on the Disaster Squad. Gary also co-authored the F.B.I.'s Latent Fingerprint Training Manual and taught the Advanced Latent Fingerprint School and the F.B.I. Academy in Quantico, VA and throughout the United States.

After retiring from the F.B.I. in 1997, Gary and his wife Peggy moved to Summerfield where he began his own consulting business, Gary W. Jones Fingerprint Services. Gary also worked for the Ocala Police Department as a latent fingerprint examiner.

Gary was a member of the International Association for Identification's (IAI), the Florida division IAI and served on the board of directors for the New Jersey division of the IAI. He was also the author of two books, "Courtroom

Testimony for the Fingerprint Expert" and "Introduction to Fingerprint Comparison."

Gary is survived by his wife, Peggy and daughter Lisa Jones of Mount Dora, FL.
