### Obituary of GEORGE BRYAN

George Russell Bryan, 79, of Umatilla, FL passed away Monday, December 26, 2011. Born in Umatilla, FL. Born to Paul William "P.W." and Opal Bryan he was a lifelong resident of Umatilla and a member of the First Baptist Church of Umatilla since he was 13 years old. After graduating Umatilla High School in 1950 he attended Florida Southern College and graduated in 1955. Mr. Bryan was in the citrus business and innovative grove caretaking using tree toppers to mechanically trim trees and along with his three sons expanded into the fern business. Mr. Bryan served on the Umatilla City Council and the first City of Umatilla zoning board, he was the first charter president of the Umatilla Jaycees and worked with the Paul W. Bryan Historical Museum. He also served on the Lake County Planning and Zoning Board and the County Agriculture Advisory Council. Mr. Bryan was an avid fisherman, diver, boater and pilot but he was proudest of his children and grandchildren. His faith in God has helped him be happy and peaceful. He is survived by his sons: Paul W. (Rose) Bryan, III, John Russell "Rusty" Bryan, Thomas Lee (Renee) Bryan all of Umatilla, FL; daughter: Jennifer Sue Bryan, Umatilla, FL; grandchildren: Jonathan Bryan, Jacksonville, FL, Shannon Bryan, Jacksonville, FL, Ashlee Morgan, Savannah, GA; Tiffany Bryan, Umatilla, FL, Kaylee Bryan, Umatilla, FL, Aimee Bryan, Umatilla, FL, Tyler Bryan, Umatilla, FL, Bryan Johnson, Umatilla, FL and several cousins.
