Monty Pilkington went Home to be with the Lord on Thursday, Nov. 4, 2010. He had been sick and in the Hospital most of the previous 22 months. He was born in Union, South Carolina on Sept. 2, 1939. He graduated from Jackson High School in Miami, FL. in 1957. He married his Wife, Soni, on July 21, 1961. They met when he was 17 years old and Soni was 15 years old and fell in love at first sight. They lived in Hialeah, FL. and North Miami, FL. until 1980 when they moved to Lake County, FL. Monty and Soni were married for 49 years and worked together, side-by-side, every day for 48 of those years. Monty is survived by two children: His Son, Monty Keith Pilkington and his wife, Karen Pilkington, of Seminole, FL. and his Daughter, Monica Pilkington of Summerfield, FL., and her Daughter, Megan Pilkington (who is Monty's only Grand-child).
