### Obituary of George Schemanske

George William Schemanske, 95, of Fruitland Park, FL, passed away on November 11, 2013. Born in Detroit, Michigan, George worked as a Circulation Manager for the Detroit Free Press until he retired and he and his wife Margaret moved to Florida. Once in Florida, they became avid ballroom dancers, attending several classes and dances weekly and participating in exhibition dances.
