Glen Stuart Cole, 80, of Umatilla, Florida, passed away on June 1, 2022. He was born in Rome, New York on January 11, 1942, to Albert L. and Laura Poile Cole, and moved with his family to Mt. Dora, Florida when he was five years old. Glen graduated from Mt. Dora High School and went on to study architectural design in Atlanta, Georgia. Glen was in the electrical business for over 30 years in the central Florida area and was the owner, operator of Cole Electrical Construction. His business and personal belief was that honesty and integrity are of utmost importance in running a business.
