Obituary of Glenn Gore

Dr. Glenn Leland Gore, M.D. passed away on July 13, 2010 after a valiant battle with pancreatic cancer. He was at his son's home with family and friends present. Dr. Gore was the son of Dr. Olin H. Gore and Martha J. Gore of St. Louis. He graduated from Southwest High School, received his Bachelor of Arts from Kansas University, and became a Doctor of Medicine from Tulane Medical School. He then received his residency in obstetrics and gynecology in San Francisco. While in California, he was a member of the California National Guard and achieved the rank of captain. He returned to St. Louis and practiced obstetrics and gynecology in the St. Louis area. He was especially proud of having delivered over 6,000 babies, the majority in the St. Louis area. Dr. Gore was a talented artist, musician, physician, and developer. He was a member of Mount Morian Masonic Lodge for 59 years. He developed and owned Town West Mobile Home Park in St. Louis and Recreation Plantation R.V. Park in Lady Lake, Florida. He is survived by his son, Grant Leland Gore, and daughter, Dr. Holly Lynn Groh, M.D. He is proud of his grandchildren, Logan Leland Gore, Taylor Lynn Gore, Sarah Ellyn Groh, Maggie Arden Groh, Jack Paul Groh, and Cait Maren Olivia Groh.
