Obituary of Guillermo Avecilla, Jr.

GUILLERMO B. AVECILLA JR. M.D., 48, of Oxford, passed away Thursday, October 28, 2010. Born in Manila, Philippines, the son of Guillermo and Estelita (Bergano) Avecilla Sr. Dr. Avecilla came to the United States in 1991, and moved here from Tampa in 2002. He was a practicing physician in Mulberry Medical Group, and on staff at The Villages Regional Hospital. He was dedicated to his practice and his patients to the very end. Dr. Avecilla was a member of the American College of Physicians and the American Board of Internal Medicine. He was a member of St. Theresa's Roman Catholic Church, Belleview. An avid runner, self-taught musician, a kind and generous person who loved to travel, and a wonderful cook and wine connoisseur, "Gilly" was a loving and devoted husband and a wonderful father.
