H.W. "Bill" died March 2, 2011. He was preceded in death by his wife of 63 years, Virginia Nelson Hall in 2003. Mr. Hall was a Veteran of WWII and was stationed in the Pacific area for 3 years. Mr. Hall attended Centre College in Danville, KY and finished his schooling at Bowling Green Business University in Bowling Green, KY. Bill was in the banking business and worked in several banks in Kentucky and Tennessee and became a State and National Bank Examiner. In 1965, he moved from Louisville, KY to Leesburg as Vice President of Citizens National Bank, and later that year became President. After he left the banking business, he and his wife, Virginia, owned and operated The Carpet Mart for 17 years. Bill is survived by 3 children, William (Bill) B. Hall, Leesburg,; Robert (Bob) S.
