Obituary of Harry H. Nichol

Harry H. "Nick" Nichol died Wednesday, January 13, 2010. Mr. Nichol was born in Indiana, PA on a 300 acre farm that supplied 5,000 fresh turkeys to area homes for the holidays. He graduated from Penn State University in Turf Mgm't/Agronomy. He was a Golf Course Superintendent for 45 years, managing courses in NY, PA, CT, NH and RI.

Mr. Nichol moved to The Villages in July, 2006. He was a patron of the Lifetime Learning College taking as many history classes as he could. He was a bass singer in The Villages Voices, Brothers in Song Glee Club, Heart of Florida Barbershop Chorus and the North Lake Presbyterian Church Choir. He enjoyed the Table Tennis Club and golf before getting ill. He was active in a special Eating-In Gourmet Group in The Villages. Playing cards and traveling were favorite pastimes.
