Obituary of Henry Baer

Henry Clinton Baer, Jr, 84, passed away on April 30, 2011. He was born in Fall River, MA on May 23, 1926 and attended schools in Massachusetts graduating with a degree in Chemical Engineering from MIT. Most of his working life was spent at B.F. Goodrich in Shelton, CT. In 1950 he married his loving wife of 60 years. Henry was a Navy veteran of World War II serving as a radar installation and repair technician stationed in Hawaii. Henry was a direct descendant of Richard Warren who came on the Mayflower and was a member of the James Chilton Colony, Florida Society of Mayflower Descendants, serving as their captain. Henry was a member of King Hiram Lodge # 12 in Shelton CT and served as Master in 1976. He was also a member of the Royal Arch Masons and Jerusalem Council #16, R&SM.
