Henry Kirk "Hank" Williams, 94, of Leesburg, Florida died March 24, 2016. He was born in Leesburg, Florida on July 6, 1921. Hank was a graduate of Leesburg High School in 1939. He served in the United States Navy Pacific Theater during WWII. Hank graduated from the University of North Carolina in 1949. He was a Church Deacon and Sunday School Teacher in various Southern Baptist Churches in Texas, Oklahoma, Georgia, and Florida for 50 years. Currently he was a member of Central Baptist Church of Leesburg and a former member of South Main Street Baptist Church of Leesburg.

Hank is survived by his wife Marjorie; daughter, Terri; and his son, Kirk. He was preceded in death by his daughter, Holly Ann.
