Obituary of Horace Root

H.L. Root, 82, passed away Wednesday, November 30, 2011 at Florida Hospital Waterman in Tavares, Florida. He was born June 5, 1929 to Norlyn and Vera (Vandeventer) Root of Mt. Sterling, Illinois. Mr. Root graduated from Mt. Sterling High School in 1947, Culver Stockton College in 1952, and Western Illinois University in 1955. He was a Staff Sergeant and meteorologist in the United States Air Force from 1950 to 1954, a high school mathematics teacher and coach at high schools in Illinois, a textbook salesman in Illinois and Kentucky. He lived the last two years in Leesburg, Florida and in Frankfort and Lawrenceburg, Kentucky prior to that.

He is preceded in death by his parents. He is survived by his wife of 30 years, Susan Betsy (Burkhalter) Root of Leesburg, Florida; his daughter, Ann Root and her husband, Ken Rauscher, of Seattle, Washington; his son, Tom Root, and his wife, Jean, of Muskego, Wisconsin; and two grandsons, Steve Root of St. Louis, Missouri and Jim Root of Columbia, Missouri.
