Obituary of Houston Roberson

Houston Franklin "Chip" Roberson, Jr., 60, of The Villages, FL went home to be with his Lord on November 6, 2012. Born November 11, 1951 in Polk County, GA, Mr. Roberson was a graduate of the University of Georgia, Class of 1976 and loved his Bulldogs, especially UGA football. He spent his professional career working as a pharmacist but his passion was in pastoring Baptist churches throughout North Carolina and Virginia. He was a selfless individual with a heart for missions and his influence was felt around the world. He received his Doctorate of Theology from SEBTS in 1998 and in 2011; Chip moved to the Villages and was a member of Cross Pointe in Ocala.
