Obituary of Hubert Bevill

Reverend Hubert G. Bevill, known to many as "Pa", passed from this life on Sunday January 11, 2015 at the age of 82. Rev. Bevill was born in Augusta, Georgia. He moved to Leesburg as a young teenager, where he met and married the love of his life and his wife of 50 years, Audrey (Ward) Bevill. Very proud of his military career, he received numerous awards for expert marksman and served in the US Army Intelligence Division in Germany and France before returning to his home and his family in Leesburg. He was a manager for BF Goodrich and owned a Firestone Tire Dealership in Leesburg. During this time, he also had a radio program and came to be known as the "Singing Tire Salesman". He enjoyed hunting, fishing, carving, and sketching. Rev. Bevill was instrumental in establishing and building 5 churches in Lake county and Pastored at three of them, including South Leesburg Church of God, Lady Lake Church of God, and Lake Hermosa Church of God. He was a Pastor in the local community for more than forty years.

His life was a life of service to God, Country, Family and Friends. He will be remembered by many for his unselfish dedication to those in need.

He is survived by his daughter, Tami Bevill; two granddaughters, Brooke Hummell and Danielle Moore; four great-grandchildren, Allysa Laufersky (10),

Sidney Hummell (9), Conner Hummell (1), and Saige Hummell (4 months); and sister, Mildred McDonald.

Funeral services will be held on Saturday, January 17 at 11 am at Beyers Funeral Home Chapel, Lady Lake with Pastor Chuck Padgett officiating. Graveside services will follow at the Lady Lake Cemetery, with military honors. Friends and family may call at the funeral home from 6 to 8 pm Friday, January 16.
