"Fern" was born August 9, 1912 to Lula H and Robert Byron Keltner in Collinsville, Oklahoma. The family moved to Yakima, Washington where her father ran a trucking business.

Fern graduated from Selah High School, and went to California to find work with the JJ Newberry Company. There she met Delbert(Deb)Troutman, they were married in Laguna Beach, California. They moved to Washington State, living in several cities. They had three sons, Byron, Robert, and Douglas. In Auburn Washington they owned "Fern and Debs" restaurant. The family moved to Whittier California in 1955.

Fern worked for Tibbets dress shop in Whittier for several years, she then returned to work for JJ Newberry Company as a dress buyer. She spent many years in the fashion industry and loved her buying trips to New York, where she always managed to "catch" tickets to the latest shows on Broadway. She finished her California employment as a successful real estate agent.

When Deb died in 1971, she moved back to Yakima to care for her elderly mother. From Yakima, she moved to Littleton, Colorado near son Byron and wife, Kathy, working for May Company. She then moved with Byron's family to Salt Lake City Utah. When Byron retired, Fern moved with them to Leesburg, Florida where she had her own home at the Plantation. When physically necessary, she moved from the plantation to the Lake Harris Health care facility.

Through the eight years at Lake Harris her greatest pleasure was her weekly trips to Michelle's salon to have her hair done. Always fastidious about her dress and grooming after those years in the fashion industry, the greatest sin of any caregiver was to "muss her hair"!

Fern is survived by son Doug and wife Dawn in Lakeview OR, granddaughter Amy who lives in Upper Hutt, New Zealand, and grandson Michael. Byron and Kathy's children are Charlene, Robert, and James. Great grandchildren are: Mary Kathleen, Kristin, Evan, triplets Benjamin, Brooklyn, Brendan; Watt and Jocie.
