In her younger days at the age of 5 she was able to enjoy ballet lessons in New York , and learned to have a great love of the city during its heyday. As a child she embraced the leadership qualities expressed from her admired mentors. She had endless stories about her schooling and desire to become a school teacher. Her tomboy days in the neighborhood found her playing stickball against the local established teams, insisting that she be included and her unorthodox ways of striking the ball(samurai like) was puzzling at first but her swing was true each and every time. She ran for treasurer of the GO club in 9th grade at Otilia M Beha JHS 60 on 11th st between aves B and A in New york. Her campaign was organized by a childhood friend complete with a song and chorus. She attended Washington Irving HS and Central Commercial HS and attended courses at NY University. She was a business wiz during her early adult career and with John, Jens father, traveled to Japan and Hong Kong. Wall st. was her career base, and her enthusiasm influenced our younger brother Harold to pursue a similar career track. Her magnetism did attract all types of people, and thank God that the vast majority were sincere who sought her counsel.

She was fiercely devoted to her younger siblings and often volunteered to help us out during difficult times. The results of her intervention were not always perfect but we understood that her heart was always in the right place.

Irma was a perpetual student, educating herself on the issues of the day and keeping up with the complexities of the American political system. Did I mention that she was opinionated? She inherited from our mother the ability to read human sincerity naturally and was not terribly impressed by ivory tower babble, and would relish the opportunity to debate on the fly. She would concede if you were right, but expect her to add this to her portfolio for further investigation. She embodied what a good American can be like with emphasis on fighting for your freedom. She was one of a kind.
