Jack W. Blum, 94, of Bushnell, Florida, died Saturday, October 29, 2011 at Bushnell, FL. He was born June 9, 1917 in York, Pennsylvania. Jack served in the U.S. navy during WWII and retired in 1970 as Corporal from the York, PA City Police Department. He received the "Ambassadors in Blue" Award in 1965 from the York, Pa.
