Mr. Jack Millican, 92, of Umatilla, Florida passed away Tuesday, April 15, 2014. Mr Millican was born in Douglas, Georgia July 2, 1921. During his early childhood he lived in Hamilton, Alabama. He graduated from high school in 1937 and attended Auburn University. He graduated from Auburn in 1947 with a B.S. in Agricultural Education. While at Auburn, he was a member of the Alpha Gamma Rho fraternity. He received his Master's Degree in Vocational Education from North Carolina State University in 1971. He also attended the University of Florida and Stetson University for special courses. He served in the United States Army during World War II and participated in several battles throughout Europe.
