A private celebration of life will be held at a later date.

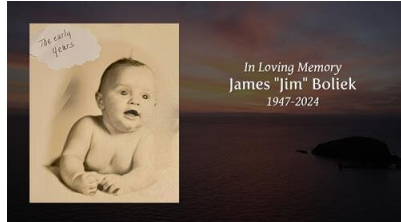
In lieu of flowers, the family has asked for charitable donations to be made in memory of Jim to the St. Jude Children's Hospital.
