Obituary of James Cook

James Franklin "Red" Cook, 68 of Lady Lake, FL died on September 8, 2016. Red was born in Pineview, GA on January 19, 1948 and moved to Fruitland Park in 1965 and was a veteran of the Vietnam War. He was employed by Coca Cola for many years and owned Cook's Zippy Mart in Fruitland Park. He retired from Massey Services Pest Extermination where he was recognized as Exterminator of the Year several times.

Red was preceded in death by his parents, Mark Daniel Cook and Mary Lacey Cook; his brothers James, Eugene, Ernest, Wendell, Robert, Mark, Sr., Harmon, and Joe Cook.

He is survived by his wife, Diane M. Cook, daughter, Wendy (Michael) Williams, and grandson Dustin, all of Lady Lake. Other survivors include sisters Ruby (Bob) Hughes of Chicago, Illinois; Mary (Tom) Carosia and Anna (Tommy) Wehunt of Perry, GA. A number of nieces and nephews also survive.
