Obituary of JAMES HARPER

James Robert Harper (Bob) went to be with the Lord on Thursday, October 29th after a long battle with cancer. He was born in Orlando, Florida, on February 2, 1947. He graduated from the University of South Florida in 1969. Subsequently, he served in the U.S. Army Reserves for six years. In the early 1970's he started in the fern business with his brother, Russ, and continued the business his Grandfather had started in 1919. His current business is Foliage Imports with his wife Leilani & Son Robbie. Bob served on the Astor St. John's Water Board and was instrumental in Astor obtaining a sewage treatment facility. Perhaps most important to Bob was his membership in the First Baptist Church in Astor. Over the years, it was his privilege to serve as a Deacon, Finance Committee, and Chairman of the Committee on the new Family Life Center Building. He is survived by his beloved wife, Leilani, his son, Robbie, his daughter-in-law, Nicole, and his grandson, Eli.
