Obituary of James Jones

James Frederick Jones, Sr. was born in Bailey, Texas, August 25, 1922, to Charles R. Jones and Mary Agnes Couzens Jones and grew up in Bonham, TX. Mr. Jones was in the U. S. Air Force during WWII. In 1950 he received his J.D. from the University of Texas, Austin, School of Law, and was a member of Delta Sigma Pi and Delta Tau Delta. He has remained a member of the Texas Bar Association since 1950, and the Georgia Bar since 1957.

Mr. Jones married Jackie Marie Farris in 1951 and they lived in Austin, TX where he served as Assistant Attorney General until 1957 when they moved to Atlanta, GA where he began his forty year career in corporate law. In 2009, they became permanent residents of Lady Lake, FL.

The Joneses were active in Wieuca Road Baptist Church where Mr. Jones served on the Diaconate and Finance Committee and taught in Bible class.

Mr. Jones is survived by his wife and children, Jim F. Jones, Jr., J. Charisse Jones Moore, and Rev. Keith K. Jones, grandchildren Erin C. Moore and Charles B.J. Moore, greatgrandchild Isabelle D. Moore and a sister Mrs. Donald Jones of Denton, TX.
