James "Jim" Joseph Malone, 86, of The Villages, FL, passed away on Sunday, January 29, 2017 at Promise Hospital. Jim was born in Vincennes, IN on April 5, 1930. He attended Hammond High, Hammond, IN and was the star baseball pitcher. After graduating in 1948, he joined the US Navy and served for four years on two aircraft carriers, the USS Wasp (CV-18) and the USS Midway (CV-41) where he worked in the boiler room to supply power to the ship. Following an honorable discharge, he returned home to work in the power generating industry retiring from AMOCO Refinery, Whiting, IN. After retirement, he moved with the love of his life, Mary Lee, to The Villages, FL where he enjoyed an active retirement lifestyle, regularly golfing and traveling.
