Obituary of James Rose

James A. Rose, age 72, died Friday, January 1, 2016 at the Villages, Florida. Known to many as "Jimbo" he made countless friends in his home state of Massachusetts and in Florida where he lived at (and loved) The Villages since 2009.

Jim was a graduate of Winchester High School and studied at Northeastern University and The Harvard School of Public Health. He served in the Air Force from 1961 to 1965 and worked at Polaroid Corporation from 1965 to 1999. There, he served as Process Engineering Aide, Safety Administrator and Construction Administrator. He also served as Supervisor of Safety and Security at Ametek Aerospace & Defense from 1999 to 2009.

Jim was married for a brief period in the seventies. He never had children, but after his divorce he was a proud, confirmed bachelor.

Jim was close to his sister Susan, the only surviving member of his immediate family. He would call her weekly at her Massachusetts home and was a great

support to her. Jim would often entertain his sister with stories of his beloved Pug, Otis. One sad day in 2013, Jim called with news that Otis had died. His "Buddy Otis" was so near and dear to him that he felt the loss of a close family member and friend.

In his later years, he enjoyed visiting friends at the Villages and racing his remote-controlled scale-model replica boats. He died peacefully amongst friends after an enjoyable evening of socializing and celebration.
