James Vartmann, 73, of Leesburg, FL., passed away on December 18, 2018. He was born June 22, 1945 to Cecelia Murphy in St Paul, MN. James graduated from St. Bernard's High School in 1963 and joined the Army from 1964-1967. He served in Vietnam. James was employed by North Central Airlines/Republic Airlines from 1967-1986. In 1986 when Northwest Airlines bought Republic Airlines he quit his job and went to work as an independent contractor as an airlines computer programmer.
