Obituary of Janet MacGregor

Janet Elizabeth MacGregor passed away on December 2, 2016. Janet was born February 11, 1926 in Mahaffey, PA to Ithamar E. Mogle and Rachel Ross Mogle. Janet was married in 1945 to Reuben M. MacGregor and had two sons Warren M. and Richard A. MacGregor.

Her earlier career was that of a piano and organ teacher, and later as a medical librarian for the Doctor's Hospital in Lanham, MD. A few years into retirement both Reuben and Janet retired to Leesburg, FL where they enjoyed activities in the Highland Lakes Community as well as a climate that allowed her to play her favorite hobby; tending to flowers or plants as well as decorating her home. Both Janet and Reuben enjoyed welcoming their many friends and family into their home, entertaining them at times on piano or organ.

Janet will be remembered best for her boundless energy, love of family, love of horticulture, and especially her love of God and country. Passionate about the church and her religion, she attended church regularly; even volunteering to play the organ for a local church in Leesburg until they could secure a permanent organist.

Janet is predeceased by her husband Reuben, parents, two brothers Bud and Dick Mogle, as well as one sister Mary Ann (Mogle) Magda and son Warren (Mickey) MacGregor. She is survived by eight nieces and nephews, a son Richard, as well as daughter-in-law Pearl MacGregor.

A memorial service is scheduled at the Morrison United Methodist Church on Tuesday at 10:00 AM with Pastor David Stauffer officiating. A viewing for friends and family will occur at 9:30 AM prior to the service.
