Obituary of Janet McCord

Janet P. McCord of Leesburg, FL, formerly of Bradford and Titusville, PA, passed away peacefully on July 11, 2015 at the Lane Purcell Hospice House following a brief illness. She was born in Bradford, PA, June 3, 1936, the daughter of the late Edward C. and Dorothy Thayer Prentice. Janet was married for 56 years to the late William G. McCord, Jr. She was also preceded in death by her brothers, Thayer and Robert.

Janet was a 1954 graduate of Bradford (PA) High School. She was known everywhere she lived for her activity in charitable organizations. She gave many hours of her life to organizations including the Bradford Welcome Wagon, the March of Dimes, the Titusville Women's Club, and the Mended Hearts Society of Leesburg Regional Medical Center, where she served as President for many years.
