Obituary of Jean Miller

JEAN V MILLER, 92, of Leesburg, Florida, passed away Monday, March 1, 2010

in Leesburg, FL. Born in Winsor, Colorado on November 26, 1917, she grew up in

Findlay, Ohio where the family had a dairy and vegetable farm. She graduated from

Bowling Green, Ohio and taught school until she married Herbert C. Miller and moved

to Florida in 1948. Jean taught elementary school for 9 years in Ohio then 24 years in

Lake County (Clermont and Skeen Elementary School). Jean was a charter member of a local teacher's Sorority ADK and enjoyed her membership throughout her life.

She was predeceased by her husband of 58 years, Herbert C. Miller.

She is survived by her daughters, Major General Polly A. Peyer (husband Ret. Col. Brian Grady) of United State Air Force; Lois Fuzzell (predeceased by husband Frank Fuzzell) of Leesburg and Page Scott (predeceased by husband Reid Scott) of Fruitland Park, FL.
