### Obituary of Jean Schuetz

Jean L. Schuetz, 81 of Lady Lake, passed away on February 18, 2014 at The Villages Hospital following complications after an accidental fall. Jean was born July 27, 1932 in Manchester, CT. She was the daughter of the late Albert and Clara (Ruot) Schuetz. She taught physical education for 36 years in the Winsted, CT school system and was noted for her ability to see the whole child socially, emotionally and physically. Three generations of students learned what good sportsmanship is under her guidance. Jean spent her summer months as a waterfront director at children's camps in CT and NY. She moved to Water Oak in Lady Lake, FL when she retired in 1991. She was an active golfer and bowler for many years. For several years she was an avid walker and did as much as four miles a day. She is survived by a nephew Craig McKnight (Stephanie) of Deerfield, OH, niece Tracee McKnight of Sevierville, TN and her best friend of 52 years Shirley Caruso of Lady Lake, FL.
