Jeannine Drouet Campbell passed away with her family at her side on Monday February, 5, 2018 due to complications following a stroke. She was 76. Mrs. Campbell was born on March 3, 1941 to Richard and Martha (Vail) Drouet in Rochester NY and grew up in Wellesley, MA.
