Joan Ann Danis went home to be with our Lord on March 24, 2021. She passed peacefully in her home in the Villages, Florida surrounded by her five children and her husband of sixty-three years, Albert Danis. Joan was born on 15 August 1938 in Winooski, VT. She was the second of six children of Armond and Fernand Mercure. After graduating from high school, Joan met the love of her life, Al Danis, from Burlington, VT.
