Joan Rae Hargis, a devoted wife, loving mother and grandmother passed away on December 6, 2025 in Murfreesboro, TN at the age of 90. She was the daughter of Walter and Lois (Carll) Klink of Olean, NY.

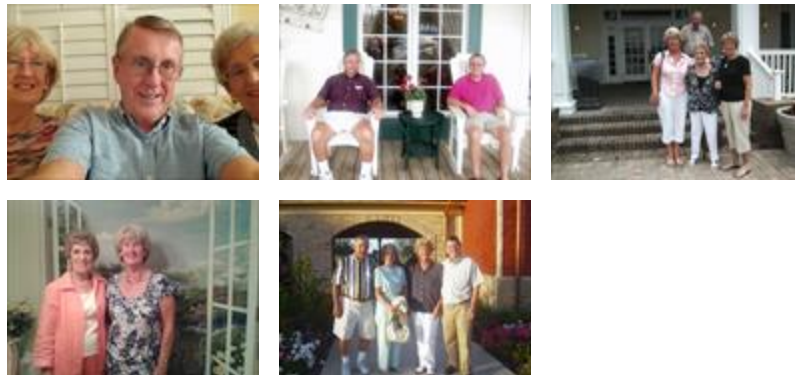
