Joan Huston Thompson died Friday March 22 at Leesburg Hospital (Leesburg Florida) after a prolonged illness. Joan was married to Gordon Thompson, her second husband. A marriage made after her first husband Dean Huston died.

Joan, a Florida native and the daughter of John Kleis (Retired in 1946 as Bandmaster for the US Naval Academy) was an active woman. She and her first husband Dean were avid fishermen - winning the Venetian Gardens Bass Open Fishing Tournament in November 2001. She was also an avid collector and the mother of two. During her marriage with Gordon, Joan amassed a large collection of Pillsbury Doughboy figurines that was so comprehensive it was featured in the May 2011 issue of The Villages Daily Sun.

In addition to fishing and collecting, Joan was a Florida State Licensed Cosmetologist and worked in the field for over 50 years. She was also a devout Catholic attending Saint Timothy Parish in Lady Lake Florida.

Joan leaves behind a husband, Gordon Thompson, two sons, Richard and Kenneth, a daughter in law Linda Huston, two Grandchildren, Dana Huston the Daughter of Richard and Kenneth Huston II, son of Kenneth. Additionally

she leaves behind four Great Grandchildren, all the children of Dana. They are JeShay, Jahmir, Jasiah, and Araya.
