Obituary of John Duffer

John Miller Duffer, 90, of Bushnell, FL, died Friday, August 15, 2014 at Sumterville, FL. He was born July 18, 1924 in Sumner County, TN. Mr. Duffer was a life member of the VFW Post #10137 in Bay Hill, FL, the DAV Everglade State Chapter #2, and the American Legion Post #101 at Beville's Corner. He enjoyed fishing, gardening, going to yard sales, flea markets, and antique stores, and was an avid collector of Budweiser Steins. He endured many battles during World War II on the USS Wasp CV-7 and survived the sinking of the ship in 1942. He went on to serve the remainder of his Naval Career on the USS Essex. Medals and Honors received during his Naval Service include the Purple Heart Medal, Presidential Unit Citation Ribbon, Good Conduct Clasp, World War II Victory Medal, Honorable Service Lapel Button, Good Conduct Medal, American-Defense Service Medal - Bronze Letter "A", American Campaign Medal, Philippine Liberation Ribbon, Navy Occupation Service Medal - "Asia" Clasp, and Honorable Discharge Button. Following his Naval Service, Mr. Duffer continued his life as a Master Mariner through his employment with Exxon Oil Co. serving as Captain on sea going tugs and also as able-bodied seaman with Exxon's super tanker fleet.

He is survived by his son, John Miller Duffer, Jr. of Nashville, TN; daughters,

Pandora Duffer of Nashville, TN, and Sandra (Paul) Woodard of Bushnell, FL; sister, Mary Barringer of Memphis, TN; half-brother and devoted caregiver, Ralph Duffer of Lafayette, TN; and three grandchildren.

He was preceded in death by his wife, lover, and friend of more than 50 years, Ernestine Meadow Duffer; and parents, Russ & Mattie Dell Duffer.
