Obituary of John Frisbie

John C. Frisbie, 96, of Deland, Florida was born September 24, 1917 in Archbald, Pennsylvania and died October 22, 2013. He was a devout Christian with a loving heart and his first priority was his Lord followed by his family. A member of the Church of Christ in Christian Unity in Endwell, NY, he was the church's Treasurer as well as 1st Elder. Locally he attended the Community Wesleyan Church of Leesburg.
