### Obituary of John Gammon

John F. Gammon, 96, of Fruitland Park, Florida, died Sunday, February 3, 2013. Mr. Gammon was born January 23, 1917 in Greenup Co., Kentucky, but spent most of his life in Pennsylvania. He was employed by the Pennsylvania Liquor Control Board for 35 years. He was Township Supervisor and Township Treasurer of Elk Township, Clarion County, PA for 27 years and was recently inducted in the PA Association of Township Supervisors Hall of Fame for his long service. He was a veteran of the US Air Corps in WWII for four years, serving in North Africa and Europe.

The Gammons moved to Fruitland Park, FL in 1980. He was a life member of Leesburg Masonic Lodge #58 F&AM; Scottish Rite Ocala, FL; Bahia Shrine Orlando, FL and Lake County Shrine Club in Tavares, FL. He was also a life member of D.A.V. and life member of Federation of Mobile Home Owners of Florida. John renewed his membership on Pentecost 2008 with the church he loved, St. Mark's UCC, Monroe, PA and was an active member at the time of his death.

He was married to Clara Best of Knox, PA for 30 years until she passed away

in February of 2002. Survivors include daughter, Vicki L. Reed and husband Randy and grandchildren, Amber, Courtney and Dylan Reed.

Local Memorial Services will be held Thursday, March 14th at 2 pm at Beyers Funeral Home Chapel, Leesburg with Reverend Bob Van Valkenberg officiating. Masonic Memorial services will also be held. Inurnment will be in Florida National Cemetery, Bushnell.
