



John E. "Jack" Keitzer

June 14, 1924 - November 25, 2022

On November 25, 2022, John E. 'Jack' Keitzer passed away at UF Health Leesburg Hospital at the age of 98. Mr. Keitzer was born in Logansport, Indiana on June 14, 1924. After graduating from Logansport High School, Jack enlisted in the US Army in 1943. Jack, as everyone called him, was a decorated Combat Infantry veteran during WWII. He was awarded the Bronze Star medal for Heroism for his active-duty service. On May 19, 1946, Jack and Betty Jo Miller married and spent the next 65 years together until Betty's death in 2012. They raised 3 children, Carla (Jerry) Goldstein, Colleen (Dennis) Richling, John Steven (Patricia) Keitzer, currently of Florida and North Carolina. Jack is survived by 3 children, 12 grandchildren, 22 great-grandchildren, and 2 great-great-grandchildren. After leaving their home state of Indiana, Jack and family moved to Boca Raton in 1962. After spending years in successful entrepreneurial businesses, retirement, travels in the US and internationally, Jack and Betty settled at the Plantation in Leesburg, FL thirty years ago. Jack spent his last year at Lake Port Square. In his lifetime, Jack was an avid supporter of the blind community, an active member of many fraternal organizations, civic associations, and a member of Morrison United Methodist Church. Jack loved to travel, sing, bowl, craft, enjoy friendships, and do jigsaw puzzles.
